Federal Work Study (FWS) Eligibility

If you are interested in becoming a student employee, you must know your eligibility for Federal Work Study (FWS) funding. If you do not know your eligibility, please submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and Student Employment Eligibility Form (SEEF) to finaid@thechicagoschool.edu to begin the process. If you do not qualify for a FWS-funded position, you may still apply for University-funded work opportunities!

International Students

If you are an international student in F-1 status, you may apply to positions that do not require FWS eligibility. Positions that do not require FWS-eligibility are listed as “On Campus (College Work Study)” in Career Hub.
